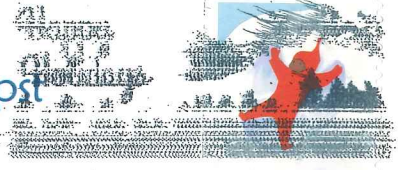

Ending homelessness, by helping a family move into a new apartment...it matters.

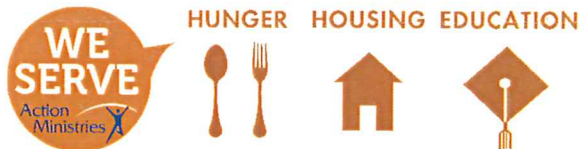
Closing the achievement gap in families, by helping a child learn to read...it matters.

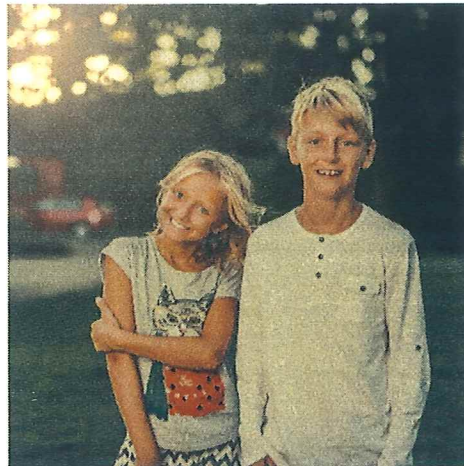
